ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP DUES

Payable annually, on the date set forth by the board of directors, as follows:

- Category I** \$12,000
(Paper manufacturers greater than \$350,000,000 annual sales to the envelope industry)
- Category II** \$6,500
(Paper and synthetic substrate manufacturers, folding equipment manufacturers, equipment components and brokers)
- Category III** \$4,500
(Gum manufacturers, printing press manufacturers, press brokers, ink manufacturers)
- Category IV** \$4,300
(Window film manufacturers and distributors)
- Category V** \$3,300
(Mailing systems manufacturers and inserting equipment providers)
- Category VI** \$2,200
(Die manufacturers, packaging equipment manufacturers)
- Category VII** \$1,400
(Printing plates and plate components, folding carton manufacturers, gumming and inspection systems)
- Category VIII*** \$1,200
(Graphic arts and software consultants, manufacturing consultants, market intermediaries, Non-North American suppliers selling outside of North America)

* Category VIII also applies to vendors having less than \$500,000 in annual product sales to the mailing or envelope manufacturing industry
